To raise knowledge and level of staff understanding by:

- Knowledge of pupils' (class, provision, whole school) communication targets

Personal Development

- To embed PSHE/RSE across the school using the Equals and SoSafe schemes of work
- Development of Celebration Days and enrichment opportunities to promote SMSC and Cultural Capital
- Careers providing relevant information and experiences for Future Destinations
- Promoting Healthy Eating within the curriculum and other opportunities
- Providing wider provision for pupils to access physical activities
- Supporting pupils with mental health and wellbeing
- Working towards a sustainable environment as part of the Trust ethos.



Continuing Professional Development (CPD)

To continue to develop a constant and consistent CPD into school staff training; incorporating relevant succession planning.

- Regular face to face staff training in staff meetings.
